

WHEN CAN I PICK UP MY ENTRIES?

Exhibit Release:

All entries will be released and ready for pick up available on Sunday, August 4 between 5:00 & 6:00 p.m. only in the Events Center. No early pick ups will be allowed. Go to each department to pick up your items. Remember to bring the stub(s) from your exhibit tag(s) or have your ID available.

HOW DO I COLLECT MY PREMIUM WINNINGS?

A table will be set up near the Creative Arts pick up area. Take your printout to the line and collect any ribbons and/or winnings due.



WHAT IF I AM UNABLE TO PICKUP MY ENTRIES AT THE SPECIFIED TIME?

Any unclaimed items will be held at the Fairgrounds Office, 500 Fairgrounds Road, Castle Rock for two weeks after the Fair has ended. Any unclaimed exhibits will be disposed of and any unclaimed premium money will be forfeited and returned to the General Fund of the Douglas County Fair & Rodeo.

CAN I HAVE SOMEONE ELSE PICK UP MY ENTRIES?

Yes, they just need to bring in the entry tag stub(s). You may have another person bring in your items on Entry day as well. You do not have to be present to enter.

You are invited to enter your Arts, Crafts, and Culinary items in the Douglas County Fair & Rodeo Creative Arts Open Division contests! Do you make quilts, take great photographs, paint, make jewelry, work on crafts, crochet, knit, put up canned goods, or bake a treasured family recipe?

JOIN US & PARTICIPATE AT THE FAIR!

Who can enter?

These contests are open to exhibitors of all ages, living in any area. Age categories are as of August 1st of the current year: Youth - Grades K-12 and up to 18 years old; Adults -19 years of age and older; and Senior Citizens - 55 years and older. Classes are open to both amateurs and professionals.

What are the Categories?

Creative Arts Departments include: Fine Arts, Crafts, Photography, Ceramics, Canning and Baking, Home Arts (needlework, sewing and embroidery); Quilts; and Senior Citizen. See specific categories at FairandRodeoFun.com.

HOW DO I ENTER AN ITEM?

Competition Rules:

Read through the official Competition Rules (CR) that apply to your entry. Find these online at FairandRodeoFun.com, by using the QR code found on the back of this brochure, by calling the Fairgrounds office at 720-733-6900, and on Entry Day at the Events Center.

EXHIBIT ENTRY DATE & TIME:

SUNDAY, JULY 28, 2024
between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
at the Douglas County Events Center

Prior to Entry Day, Entry Forms are available:

- online at fairandrodeofun.com - download, print out, and fill in;
- to pick up in person at the Fairgrounds office;
- or at the CSU Extension office (across from the Douglas County Events Center).

Manila Exhibitor Tags can also be picked up ahead of time at either office or on Entry Day, but are not available online.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE:

1 Fill out the Entry Form using one of the above methods or complete one onsite during Entry Day. Take it to the Entry table where staff will enter your personal information and issue you an Exhibitor Number. You will need this number for each manila-colored Exhibitor Tag you fill out (which will be attached to its related exhibit). Team members will be available to answer any questions.

2 When all manila Exhibitor Tag(s) and Entry Form(s) are completed, take them to each department(s) Superintendent for check-in. The Superintendent will return the stub portion of the Exhibitor Tag(s) and Entry Form(s). When you have completed the check-in process, stop at the designated exit and we will make a copy of your Entry Form(s) for you to take with you.

3 Bring the copy of your Entry form(s) and your Exhibitor Tag stub(s) with you when you pick up your exhibit(s) on **Release Day - Sunday, August 4, 2024 from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.**

WHEN ARE ENTRIES JUDGED?

Creative Arts entries will be judged on Monday, July 29, 2024.

CAN I WATCH THE JUDGING?

Quilt judging is open to the public in the Events Center starting at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, July 29, 2024 & will conclude when all quilts have been judged.

All other Creative Arts Departments are closed to the public during judging.

WHERE AND WHEN CAN I SEE MY ITEM ON DISPLAY, AND IS THERE A FEE TO SEE IT?

All of the Open Division Creative Arts Department entries will be housed in the Events Center (a.k.a. the Marketplace). Creative Arts entrants will receive one wristband for free Fair entry to view the Creative Arts exhibits during Events Center open hours.

Viewing Times:

Creative Arts Open Class Department entries/exhibits are displayed at the Events Center during the following days and times:

Thursday, August 1 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
